Registration and consultation in accordance with the Prostitute Protection Act

If you are working as a prostitute in Bavaria, you must undergo a health consultation and register in accordance with the Prostitute Protection Act.

However, due to the current **coronavirus pandemic**, most competent authorities are closed.

At the moment, no health consultations and registrations are taking place.

Important current information:

- The **use, initiation and practice of prostitution** is **prohibited** until further notice (Section 2 Paragraph 5 Clause 1, Section 4 Paragraph 2, 3 No. 3 Bavarian Infection Prevention Measures Ordinance).
- **Prostitution facilities**, i.e. all brothels, massage and table-dance establishments, are **closed** until further notice (Section 2 Paragraph 1 Clause 1 Bavarian Infection Prevention Measures Ordinance).
- **Violations** will be **sanctioned** (Section 5 No. 2, No. 9 Bavarian Infection Prevention Measures Ordinance).

Where to go if you need a doctor and are not insured in Germany

- If you are experiencing any **symptoms that resemble COVID-19**, please **call your general practitioner** first.
- If you **do not have a general practitioner** or are experiencing severe symptoms of the disease, you can contact the **on-call medical service** on the telephone number **116 117**. If necessary, a doctor on duty will visit you and take the swab sample for the laboratory test.

Available financial assistance

Emergency coronavirus assistance

- The federal government is granting **emergency financial assistance** to small businesses and the **self-employed** with up to ten employees, the Bavarian government to small and medium-sized companies as well as the self-employed and those in the liberal professions with up to 250 employees with registered offices in Bavaria.
- The **prerequisite** for this is a **liquidity shortage**, i.e. where as a result of the corona pandemic the continuous income from business activities is not expected to be sufficient to pay liabilities arising from the continuous acquisition-related material and financial expenses (e.g. commercial rent, leases, leasing instalments) in the three months following the application. **Private ongoing costs** (private rent, private health insurance, etc.) **cannot be claimed**.
- Companies and the **self-employed** from all over Bavaria can **apply for both types of emergency assistance electronically** on the website of the State Ministry of Economics, Regional Development and Energy; www.stmwi.bayern.de/soforthilfe-corona/.
